# Matchmaking


Matchmaking between students with startup ideas and founders with experience establishing and growing startup companies for mentoring sessions.


## How To Run Startup School

Organize a Half or Full Day Session Between The Students and The Founders to Learn and Share Experience.

Identify Students Champions and Networks Passionate About Entrepreneurship and Work With Them to Organize The Meetup Announce The Date of The Startup School Meetup Through Student Network, Social Media Platforms, etc. The Sessions Should be Fun and Entertaining to Students.You Should Encourage Students to Ask Questions and Engage With The Founders. Request the Founders to Spare Sometime With The Stuents.

# How to recruit founders?

Organizers of the Startup School programme can work with local innovation hubs, business incubators, and entrepreneur networks to recruit founders who will work with students in their entrepreneurial journey.

# Sample Topics For Startup School Sessions

#### How to Start

Discuss how to start; how to select problems to solve, how to assess whether the idea makes sense, where to seek help, etc.

# **Building Teams**

Discuss how to identify and recruit co-founders and the first hire of your startup team. How to incentives them, etc.

## **Handling Failure**

Discuss ways to handle drawbacks and disappointments in building startup companies, on and off campus, etc.

# How to Formalize

Discuss how to build systems and structures will help in business formalization. Where to go and who to engage in the process.

# **Execution Strategy**

Discuss how to develop strong execution strategy that gurantees success moving from ideas to startup company, dos and don'ts.

# Founder's Culture

Discuss how to develop entrepreneurial culture; a culture of first learning, commitment, taking risks, etc.
